

Surveys N^o 1286 & 1289

Plat and description of the survey of a tract of sixty seven acres and seventy eight hundredths of an acre of land, situated in the St. Louis Prairie des Noyers fields, in Township forty five, North of the base line, Range seven East of the fifth principal Meridian, in the State of Missouri, executed in the month of October eighteen hundred thirty eight, by Joseph C. Brown, Deputy Surveyor under his contract with the Surveyor of the public lands in the States of Illinois and Missouri, dated the fifteenth of September eighteen hundred and thirty five. This being the lot of two by forty arpens surveyed in the month of August seventeen hundred eighty eight, by Pierre Chouteau for Jeannette, and confirmed to Charles Gratiot assignee of Jeannette Flore on the nineteenth of November eighteen hundred and eleven by the Board of Commissioners appointed under the act of Congress of the second of March eighteen hundred and five, entitled: "an act for ascertaining and adjusting titles and claims to land within the Territory of Orleans and the District of Louisiana." (Commissioners certificate N^o 1286). It was also confirmed by the same Board to Jeannette a free Negro woman on the twentieth of November eighteen hundred and eleven, under their certificate N^o 1289 (See American State Papers Vol II page 602 Duff Green's edition) and the extent and boundaries of this lot were proven on the thirtieth of April eighteen hundred twenty five by Susanna Jeannette a colored woman, before Theodore Hawk, United States Recorder of land titles for the State of Missouri, under the provisions of the act of Congress of the twenty sixth of May eighteen hundred and twenty four, entitled: "an act supplementary to an act passed on the thirteenth day of June one thousand eight hundred and twelve, entitled: "an act making further provision for settling the claims to land in the Territory of Missouri?"
