DESCRIPTION: The State Emergency Management Agency (SEMA) produces a Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) applicant file for each applicant of a presidentially declared disaster in which the Hazard Mitigation Assistance (HMA) Program is included. This also includes the pre-disaster grant programs under the HMA program: Pre Disaster Mitigation (PDM) Program, Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) Program, Repetitive Flood Claim (RPC) Program and the Severe Repetitive Loss (SRL) Program. Each HMA applicant file contains all financial and programmatic records, supporting documents and other records pertaining to the identified applicant HMA Program grants in the specified disaster. 44 CFR 206-204 (c) sets programmatic timelines that must be followed by each applicant. Timelines begin on the date a major disaster or emergency is declared and all work must be completed within 48 months unless an extension has been granted by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).
