

EMANCIPATION DOCUMENT ONLY IN FILE - 20 OCT 1862
JESSE STEPHENSON FREED HIS NEGRO WOMAN WINNIE

Know all men by these presents, that I, Jesse Stephenson, of the County of Toddaway and State of Missouri, do hereby Emancipate and set free, my Negro Woman Winnie, And I do further declare, that, from this day, henceforth, She is free to act for herself, and go wheresoever she may think best for herself, and that she is free to do and perform all other acts which a free person may of right do, in accordance with law, And further, that henceforth and forever, she is entitled to, and has her freedom against the lawful claim or claims of myself, or my heirs, or any person whomsoever,
