Enrolled: September <sup>*29*</sup>~~5~~, 1847.

Where: Fort Leavenworth.

Period: During the war with Mexico.

Mustered into service September <sup>*29*</sup>~~10~~, 1847.

Where: Fort Leavenworth.

Honorably discharged October 2, 1848, at Independence, Mo.

NOTE.—This Battalion was also known as "Gilpin's Bat. Mo. Mtd. Vols.," "Indian Bat. Mo. Vols.," and "Bat. Mo. Vols. for the Plains."

This Co. was organized in St. Louis, Mo., in August, 1847.

Remarks: *M.A. April 30, 1848: Private Meyer, sick in bed and dangerously ill in Fort Leavenworth at the original Muster*
