Appears on "Muster roll of Capt. Rainey's Volunteer Company of Osage Volunteers for the Texas campaign."

Company was organized in Osage county and reported at St. Louis May 21, 1846, to Robt. Campbell, Col. Mo. Militia, and A. D. C. to Commander-in-Chief. By him it was reported to Col. Wm Davenport, 1st Reg't U. S. Inf., commanding at Jefferson Barracks, for muster into the U. S. service, which he declined to do.

The Co. was detained in St. Louis eight days, per certificate of Col. Campbell, and was paid for eight days service, with clothing, subsistence and travel allowance, by the U. S.
