Private, Capt. Joseph L. Stephens' Co.
(Cooper Co. Vol. Riflemen.)

Appears on "List of the Cooper County Volunteer Riflemen from 2d Brigade, 5th Div., M. M., enrolled at Boonville, Cooper County, on the 19th of May, 1846."

Company reported at St. Louis, May 24, 1846, to Robt. Campbell, Col. M. M., and A. D. C. to Commander-in-Chief. By him it was reported to Col. Wm Davenport, 1st Reg't U. S. Inf., commanding at Jefferson Barracks, for muster into the U. S. service, which he declined to do.

The Co. was detained in St. Louis five days, per certificate of Col. Campbell, and was paid for five days service, with clothing, subsistence and travel allowance, by the U. S.
