(Franklin Volunteers.)

Appears on "List of volunteers enrolled in Franklin Co., Mo., May 19, 1846, by order of G. A. Parsons, Adjutant General of Missouri."

Capt Stevenson signs list as "Captain commanding 2d Co., 13th Reg't, 2d Brig., 6th Div., Mo. Militia."

Company reported at St. Louis, May 21, 1846, to Robt. Campbell, Col. M. M., and A. D. C. to Commander-in-Chief. By him it was reported to Col. Wm Davenport, 1st Reg't U. S. Inf., commanding at Jefferson Barracks, for muster into the U. S. service, which he declined to do.

The Co. was detained in St. Louis eight days, per certificate of Col. Campbell, and was paid for eight days service, with clothing, subsistence and travel allowance, by the U. S.
