NOTE.—The muster roll of this Co. is not with the pay roll. The Co. was organized in Cole county and proceeded to St. Louis, where it reported to Robt. Campbell, Col. M. M., and A. D. C., to Commander-in-Chief. By him it was reported to Col. Wm. Davenport, 1st U. S. Inf., commanding at Jefferson Barracks, for muster into the U. S. service, which he declined to do.

The pay roll is for the 5 days the Co. was detained in St. Louis, with clothing, subsistence and travel allowance, from Cole Co., which was allowed by the U. S.
