The twelfth chapter deals with the years of the Watergate scandal, from 1975 to 1980. The thirteenth chapter covers the years of the Reagan era, from 1980 to 1989. The fourteenth chapter is devoted to the years of the Clinton era, from 1993 to 2001. The fifteenth chapter deals with the years of the Bush era, from 2001 to 2009. The sixteenth chapter covers the years of the Obama era, from 2009 to 2017. The seventeenth chapter is devoted to the years of the Trump era, from 2017 to 2021. The eighteenth chapter deals with the years of the Biden era, from 2021 to the present.
