N. B.—Every item of information should be carefully supplied. AGE should be stated EXACTLY. PHYSICIANS should state CAUSE OF DEATH in plain terms, so that it may be properly classified. Exact statement of OCCUPATION is very important.

The first part of the book is devoted to a general introduction to the subject of the history of the United States. It begins with a chapter on the early years of the Republic, from the time of the signing of the Declaration of Independence in 1776 to the end of the War of 1812. This is followed by a chapter on the period of the Jacksonian era, from 1820 to 1845. The third chapter covers the years from 1845 to 1860, and the fourth chapter deals with the Civil War and Reconstruction, from 1860 to 1877. The fifth chapter is devoted to the period of the Gilded Age, from 1877 to 1900. The sixth chapter covers the years from 1900 to 1917, and the seventh chapter deals with the period of the Progressive Era, from 1917 to 1933. The eighth chapter is devoted to the years from 1933 to 1945, and the ninth chapter covers the period of the New Deal, from 1945 to 1960. The tenth chapter is devoted to the years from 1960 to 1980, and the eleventh chapter covers the period of the Vietnam War, from 1980 to 1990. The final chapter is devoted to the years from 1990 to the present.
