RIVER YIELDS BODY OF MAN DROWNED AFTER BEER SPREE

The body of Mickey Clancy, about 49 years old, 5612 Prospect avenue, who was drowned Saturday morning in the Missouri river at the foot of Liberty street, was identified Wednesday at the Reppert mortuary in Buckner, Mo.,

Clancy's death followed prolonged beer drinking with Wm. Glasscock, 59, 6119 Agnes avenue. Friday morning Glasscock and Clancy started drinking in several joints in the Central Industrial district, Glasscock told police.

Early Saturday morning they went to the foot of Liberty street and went to sleep on the river bank, Glasscock said. A few hours later, Glasscock was awakened by a shout, he said, and saw Clancy's head disappear below the water several hundred feet from the bank.

Glasscock was picked up by police after he told of the drowning at the Prospect avenue address, where Clancy lodged. He was released Sunday morning.

Clancy's body was discovered in the river yesterday one mile west of Sibley by employees of the United States river survey.

Identification was made by O. E. Irwin, at whose home Clancy lodged, and Joseph Murphy, 1316 Troost avenue. John Costello, member of the homicide

bureau, said there was no evidence of foul play.

Police today were attempting to locate relatives of Clancy's in St. Paul, his birthplace.
