Negro Dies As Truck, Transport Sideswipe Friday

Funeral services were conducted Sunday afternoon for Levi Judon, alias Henry Jones, 36 year-old Negro who was instantly killed in an accident which occurred Friday on Highway 60 five miles east of here.

Earl Stallings was driving east on the highway hauling a tractor in the truck bed. In the cab with him was Floyd Gregory of Wyatt, Judon and three Negro companions, Tommy Green, 28, Harry Coleman, 43, and Roosevelt Williams, 26, were riding in back with the tractor.

According to Trooper John Tandy, who investigated the accident, behind the Stallings truck was an automobile transport of Pontiac, Michigan driven by Frank Roper, 29, of Harrisburg, Ill. On it was one automobile. According to a report, the transport attempted to pass the truck and in doing so the two sideswiped, the Stallings truck overturning in a ditch pinning Judon beneath the tractor.

Trooper Tandy and witnesses to the accident measured the highway at the scene of the accident and found that the highway at that point is one inch narrower than called for in the specifications.
