## 11 CSR 50-6.010 Ski Mirror

PURPOSE: Under section 306.120, RSMo, the Missouri State Highway Patrol shall establish an approved ski mirror for the safety and well-being of the public.

(1) Ski mirrors, affixed to a boat or vessel, shall be of a type that recurves and reflects one hundred eighty degrees  $(180^{\circ})$  of vision. The reflecting portion of the mirror shall be no less than three inches (3") in width and eight inches (8") in length.
