EMERGENCY RESCISSION

13 CSR 70-3.310 Chiropractic Services

PURPOSE: This rule is being rescinded as the program is no longer a covered MO HealthNet Service.

*EMERGENCY STATEMENT: The Department of Social Services (DSS), MO HealthNet Division (MHD) finds that this emergency amendment is necessary to inform citizens that the chiropractic program is no longer a covered MO HealthNet service effective July 1, 2026. As a result, the MHD finds a compelling governmental interest, which requires this emergency action. A proposed amendment, which covers the same material, will be published in the September 1, 2026, issue of the **Missouri Register**. The scope of this emergency amendment is limited to the circumstances creating the emergency and complies with the protections extended by the **Missouri** and **United States Constitutions**. The MHD believes this emergency amendment to be fair to all interested parties under the circumstances. The emergency amendment was filed July 27, 2026, effective Aug. 10, 2026, and expires Feb. 25, 2027.*

Emergency amendment filed July 27, 2026, effective Aug. 10, 2026, and expires Feb. 25, 2027. PUBLIC COST: This emergency amendment will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the time the emergency is effective.

PRIVATE COST: This emergency amendment will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the time the emergency is effective.
