## **Orders of Rulemaking**

This section will contain the final text of the rules proposed by agencies. The order of rulemaking is required to contain a citation to the legal authority upon which the order or rulemaking is based; reference to the date and page or pages where the notice of proposed rulemaking was published in the *Missouri Register*; an explanation of any change between the text of the rule as contained in the notice of proposed rulemaking and the text of the rule as finally adopted, together with the reason for any such change; and the full text of any section or subsection of the rule as adopted which has been changed from that contained in the notice of proposed rulemaking. The effective date of the rule shall be not less than thirty (30) days after the date of publication of the revision to the *Code of State Regulations*.

he agency is also required to make a brief summary of the general nature and extent of comments submitted in support of or opposition to the proposed rule and a concise summary of the testimony presented at the hearing, if any, held in connection with the rulemaking, together with a concise summary of the agency's findings with respect to the merits of any such testimony or comments which are opposed in whole or in part to the proposed rule. The ninety-(90-) day period during which an agency shall file its order of rulemaking for publication in the Missouri Register begins either: 1) after the hearing on the proposed rulemaking is held; or 2) at the end of the time for submission of comments to the agency. During this period, the agency shall file with the secretary of state the order of rulemaking, either putting the proposed rule into effect, with or without further changes, or withdrawing the proposed rule.

#### Title 3—DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION Division 10—Conservation Commission Chapter 7—Wildlife Code: Hunting: Seasons, Methods, Limits

#### **ORDER OF RULEMAKING**

By the authority vested in the Conservation Commission under sections 40 and 45 of Art. IV, Mo. Const., the commission amends a rule as follows:

#### 3 CSR 10-7.440 is amended.

This rule establishes hunting seasons and limits and is exempted by section 536.021, RSMo, from the requirement for filing as a proposed amendment.

The Department of Conservation amended 3 CSR 10-7.440 by establishing seasons and limits for hunting migratory game birds and waterfowl during the 2018-2019 seasons.

### 3 CSR 10-7.440 Migratory Game Birds and Waterfowl: Seasons, Limits

(3) Seasons and limits are as follows:

(A) Mourning doves, Eurasian collared-doves, and white-winged doves may be taken from one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to sunset from September 1 through November 29. Limits: fifteen (15) doves daily in the aggregate; forty-five (45) in possession;

(B) Sora and Virginia rails may be taken from one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to sunset from September 1 through November 9. Limits: twenty-five (25) rails daily in the aggregate; seventy-five (75)

in possession;

(C) Woodcock may be taken from one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to sunset from October 15 through November 28. Limits: three (3) woodcock daily; nine (9) in possession;

(D) Wilson's snipe may be taken from one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to sunset from September 1 through December 16. Limits: eight (8) snipe daily; twenty-four (24) in possession;

(E) Blue-winged, green-winged, and cinnamon teal may be taken from sunrise to sunset from September 8 through September 23. Limits: six (6) teal daily in the aggregate; eighteen (18) in possession.

(F) Waterfowl Zones: The North Zone shall be that portion of Missouri north of a line running west from the Illinois border at Lock and Dam 25; west on Lincoln County Hwy. N to Mo. Hwy. 79; south on Mo. Hwy. 79 to Mo. Hwy. 47; west on Mo. Hwy. 47 to I-70; west on I-70 to U.S. Hwy. 63; north on U.S. Hwy. 63 to U.S. Hwy. 24, west on U.S. Hwy. 24 to Mo. Hwy. 10, west on Mo. Hwy. 10 to U.S. Hwy. 69, north on U.S. Hwy. 69 to Mo. Hwy. 116, west on Mo. Hwy. 116 to U.S. Hwy. 59, south on U.S. Hwy. 59 to the Kansas border. The South Zone shall be that portion of Missouri south of a line running west from the Illinois border on Mo. Hwy. 74 to Mo. Hwy. 25; south on Mo. Hwy. 25 to U.S. Hwy. 62; west on U.S. Hwy. 62 to Mo. Hwy. 53; north on Mo. Hwy. 53 to Mo. Hwy. 51; north on Mo. Hwy. 51 to U.S. Hwy. 60; west on U.S. Hwy. 60 to Mo. Hwy. 21; north on Mo. Hwy. 21 to Mo. Hwy. 72; west on Mo. Hwy. 72 to Mo. Hwy. 32; west on Mo. Hwy. 32 to U.S. Hwy. 65; north on U.S. Hwy. 65 to U.S. Hwy. 54; west on U.S. Hwy. 54 to the Kansas border. The Middle Zone shall be the remainder of Missouri not included in other zones.

(G) During years when the federal framework prescribes a sixty-(60-) day duck season, the North Zone season will open on the first Saturday in November, the Middle Zone season will open on the Saturday nearest November 6 for seven (7) days, close for five (5) days, and then re-open for fifty-three (53) days, the South Zone season will open on Thanksgiving Day for four (4) days, close as long as necessary for the second segment to remain open until the last Sunday in January (as late as the federal framework allows). During years when the federal framework prescribes a forty-five- (45-) day duck season, the North Zone season will open on the second Saturday in November, the Middle Zone season will open on the Saturday nearest November 15, and the South Zone season will open on the Saturday nearest December 10, close December 20-25, and then re-open on December 26 through the last Sunday in January (as late as the federal framework allows). During years when the federal framework prescribes a thirty- (30-) day duck season, the North Zone season will open on the Saturday nearest November 14, the Middle Zone season will open on the Saturday nearest November 19, and the South Zone season will open on the Saturday nearest December 15, close December 19-25, and then re-open on December 26 through the Sunday nearest January 20 (as late as the federal framework allows). A person possessing the appropriate state and federal permits may take ducks in accordance to the season lengths, bag limits, and species-specific opening and closing dates established annually by the Conservation Commission.

(H) Ducks and coots may be taken from one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to sunset as follows:

1. Ducks and coots may be taken from November 3 through January 1 in the North Zone; from November 3 through November 9 and November 15 through January 6 in the Middle Zone; and from November 22 through November 25 and December 3 through January 27 in the South Zone; and

2. Duck and coot limits are as follows: The daily bag limit of ducks is six (6) and may include no more than four (4) mallards (no more than two (2) of which may be female), three (3) wood ducks, two (2) redheads, two (2) hooded mergansers, three (3) scaup, two (2) pintails, one (1) mottled duck, two (2) canvasback, and two (2) black ducks. The possession limit is eighteen (18), including no more

than twelve (12) mallards (no more than six (6) of which may be female), nine (9) wood ducks, six (6) redheads, six (6) hooded mergansers, nine (9) scaup, six (6) pintails, three (3) mottled ducks, six (6) canvasbacks, and six (6) black ducks. The daily limit of coots is fifteen (15) and the possession limit for coots is forty-five (45).

(I) Geese may be taken from one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to sunset as follows:

1. Blue, snow, and Ross's geese may be taken from November 11 through February 6, statewide;

2. White-fronted geese may be taken from November 11 through February 6, statewide;

3. Canada geese and brant may be taken from October 6 through October 14 and from November 11 through February 6, statewide; and

4. Goose limits are as follows: The daily bag limit is three (3) Canada geese and brant in aggregate, twenty (20) blue, snow, or Ross's geese, and two (2) white-fronted geese, statewide. The possession limit is nine (9) Canada geese and brant in aggregate and six (6) white-fronted geese. There is no possession limit for blue, snow, and Ross's geese;

(J) Ducks, geese, brant, and coots may be taken by youth hunters fifteen (15) years of age or younger from October 20 through October 21 in the North Zone; from October 20 through October 21 in the Middle Zone; and from November 17 through November 18, in the South Zone. The daily and possession limits for ducks, geese, and coots are the same as during the regular duck, goose, and coot hunting seasons. Any person fifteen (15) years or younger may participate in the youth waterfowl hunting days without permit provided they are in the immediate presence of an adult eighteen (18) years of age or older. If the youth hunter does not possess a hunter education certificate card, the adult must be properly licensed (i.e., must meet any permit requirements that allow small game hunting) and have in his/her possession a valid hunter education certificate card unless they were born before January 1, 1967. The adult may not hunt ducks but may participate in other seasons that are open on the special youth days;

(K) Shells possessed or used while hunting waterfowl and coots statewide, and for other wildlife as designated by posting on public areas, must be loaded with material approved as nontoxic by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service.

(L) Persons who possess a valid Conservation Order permit may chase, pursue, and take blue, snow, and Ross's geese from one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to one-half (1/2) hour after sunset from February 7 through April 30. Any other regulation notwithstanding, methods for the taking of blue, snow, and Ross's geese include using shotguns capable of holding more than three (3) shells, and with the use or aid of recorded or electrically amplified bird calls or sounds, or recorded or electrically amplified imitations of bird calls or sounds. An exception to the above permit requirement includes any person fifteen (15) years of age or younger, provided either 1) s/he is in the immediate presence of a properly licensed adult (must possess a Conservation Order permit) who is eighteen (18) years of age or older and has in his/her possession a valid hunter education certificate card, or was born before January 1, 1967, or 2) s/he possesses a valid hunter education certificate card. A daily bag limit will not be in effect February 7 through April 30 (See 3 CSR 10-5.436 and 3 CSR 10-5.567 for Conservation Order Permit requirements); and

(M) Migratory game birds, to include only doves, ducks, mergansers, and coots, may be taken by hunters with birds of prey as follows (See 3 CSR 10-9.442 for additional provisions about falconry including season lengths and limits for wildlife other than migratory game birds. See 3 CSR 10-9.440 for falconry permit requirements):

1. Doves may be taken from September 1 through December 16 from one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to sunset. Daily limit: three (3) doves; possession limit: nine (9) doves, except that any waterfowl taken by falconers must be included within these limits; and

2. Ducks, mergansers, and coots may be taken from sunrise to sunset from September 8 through September 23 statewide, and from one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to sunset as follows: in the North

Zone, October 20 through October 21, November 3 through January 1, and February 10 through March 10; in the Middle Zone, October 20 through October 21, November 3 through November 9, November 15 through January 6, and February 10 through March 10; and, in the South Zone, November 17 through November 18, November 22 through November 25, December 3 through January 27, and February 10 through March 10. Daily limit: three (3) birds singly or in the aggregate, including doves; possession limit: nine (9) birds singly or in the aggregate, including doves.

SUMMARY OF PUBLIC COMMENTS: Seasons and limits are exempted from the requirement of filing as a proposed amendment under section 536.021, RSMo.

This amendment was filed April 9, 2018, becomes effective May 15, 2018.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed amendment was published in the *Missouri Register* on December 15, 2017 (42 MoReg 1825–1831). No changes have been made in the text of the proposed amendment, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed amendment becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission received one (1) comment on the proposed amendment.

COMMENT #1: On January 9, 2018, AquaLaw PLC attorney Kate Claflin Creef wrote an email on behalf of the Association of Missouri Clean Water Agencies (AMCA) to Commission Secretary Pam Harlan. Creef wrote that AMCA asked that 7 CSR 10-3.010(4)(B)2.B. be amended to require that encased utilities have detector tape placed one foot (1') above the backfill, instead of placed one foot (1') above the encasement.

RESPONSE: On February 9, 2018, MoDOT staff discussed the comment with the originator of AMCA's comment, Mark Griffin, from the Kansas City Water District (KCWD). KCWD was concerned about the limits of the detector tape but after discussion understands the intent of the rule and has withdrawn their comment. As a result, the final order for this rule does not incorporate the public comment, and does not change the rule previously approved by the commission.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: The board received six (6) comments in response to the proposed amendment.

COMMENT #1: CVS Health asked the board to amend subsection (6)(B) to allow production of required records within twenty-four (24) hours of a request from the board or the board's designee in lieu of the proposed two (2) hours.

RESPONSE: The proposed two (2) hour production of records requirement is consistent with other board records requirements and appropriate for the nature of activities being performed. No change has been made in response to the comment.

COMMENT #2: CVS Health suggested modifying subsection (7)(A) to clarify that notification to the patient's primary health care provider is only required if a primary health care provider is identified by the patient.

RESPONSE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: The comment is consistent with the board's intent. Subsection (7)(A) has been amended as suggested to provide clarity.

COMMENT #3: CVS Health suggested the board delete proposed section (8) which requires biennial filing of a Notification of Intent to administer medication by prescription order.

RESPONSE: The biennial notification requirement would allow the board to identify and track pharmacists administering medication by prescription order. Significantly, the proposed amendment aligns the required notification with pharmacy renewals to better accommodate licensees and reduce required filings. No change has been made in response to the comment.

COMMENT #4: The Missouri Academy of Family Physicians (MAFP) opposed amending paragraph (6)(A)4. which would require that pharmacist administration records include the name and address of the patient's primary health care provider or an "indication that a primary health care provider was not provided." MAFP suggested the amendment is unnecessary because the prescription order must have originated from a provider, prescriber, or physician.

RESPONSE: While the prescription order must originate from an authorized prescriber, the patient may not have a "primary health care provider." This issue was specifically raised with indigent or uninsured patients that may not be under a healthcare practitioner's regular care. The proposed amendment was intended to clarify that pharmacy records must clearly identify when a primary health care provider is not designated or identified by the patient. No change has been made in response to the comment.

COMMENT #5: MAFP suggested the board retain the seventy-two (72) hour prescriber notification requirement.

RESPONSE: The board has received complaints from both prescribers and pharmacists indicating the seventy-two (72) hour notification requirement is burdensome and unnecessary. The board believes the proposed fourteen (14) day notification will protect the public while reducing unnecessary regulation. Additionally, section 338.010.13, RSMo, requires notification to the primary health care provider within fourteen (14) days of administering a vaccine. No change has been made in response to the comment.

COMMENT #6: MAFP suggested the board mandate reporting to the state immunization registry to prevent duplicate and unnecessary immunizations.

RESPONSE: The board agrees reporting to the state immunization registry would be beneficial for both prescribers and patients. Legislation is currently pending to require ShowMeVax reporting as suggested. Accordingly, no change has been made in response to the comment at this time. However, the board may reconsider the suggestion if legislation is not enacted.

(7) Notification Requirements. Pharmacists administering or supervising administration of medication under this rule, shall ensure:

(A) The patient's primary health care provider, if provided by the patient, is notified of the following within fourteen (14) days of administering a vaccine:

- 3. The route of administration;
- 4. The anatomic site of the administration;
- 5. The dose administered; and

Energy-saving investments may include projects such as insulation, lighting systems, heating and cooling systems, combined heat and power, pumps, motors, aerators, renewable energy systems, and other measures that reduce energy use and cost. Recipients repay loans with money saved on energy costs.

**Eligible Energy-Using Sectors:** Loan funds will be allocated to eligible energy-using sectors as follows:

### Combined Heat and Power Projects (CHP) – 50% of available funds:

- City/County owned and operated nursing homes or assisted living facilities;
- Public and Private Higher Education Institutions;
- Public and Private not-for-profit Hospitals; and
- City/County owned and operated correctional facilities.

#### Any energy-saving project – 50% of available funds:

• Public and Private not-for-profit Hospitals.

**Application Procedures**: An application for loan funds may be submitted to the department for the purpose of financing all or a portion of the cost of implementing an energy-saving project.

Each applicant may apply for a loan not to exceed one (1) million dollars. Loan applications will not be considered for less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or with a payback score of less than six (6) months.

If funds remain after review and priority ranking of applications, the department will consider awarding loans in excess of one (1) million dollars.

Requests for loan financing must be made using the Division of Energy's Energy Loan Program Application Authorization Form, Fuel Use Summary Form, and Energy Conservation Measure Summary Form. Application forms and instructions are available on the department's website: http://energyloan.mo.gov.

The Application Authorization Form must be signed and dated by an authorized official. An authorized official is an individual with authority to obligate an eligible applicant to the terms of loan agreement and promissory note to repay loan proceeds.

A paper or electronic copy of the signed original Application Authorization Form and required documents may be submitted to the department's address below.

Applications received after July 15, 2018 will not be considered for a loan award for this 2018 special cycle but may be held for consideration during subsequent application cycles.

The department may request additional information as needed to determine the feasibility of a project, the project's estimated annual energy savings, and financial risks of a loan transaction. Also, an energy conservation measure has the potential of affecting other areas within the facility or system. Applicants must have no outstanding actions for violations of applicable federal, state, or local laws, ordinances, and rules.

**Interest Rates**: Loan principal plus two and three quarters percent (2.75%) interest is to be repaid to the department in semi-annual payments not to exceed a ten (10) year repayment period. An administrative fee of one percent (1%) of loan principal will be added to the repayment amount.

**Selection Criteria**: Recipients of loan financing will be determined on a competitive basis. Applications will be ranked based on the project's payback score, which is determined by dividing the cost to implement a project by the estimated yearly energy cost savings. Projects with the lowest payback score in each sector allocation will be funded until all available funds are allocated. If all funds are not allocated in any one (1) sector after ranking payback scores, the department may allocate funds to other sectors. Loan applications will be approved or disapproved by October 15, 2018.

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
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
