

**T**his section will contain the final text of the rules proposed by agencies. The ninety-(90-) day period during which an agency shall file its Order of Rulemaking for publication in the *Missouri Register* begins either: 1) after the hearing on the Proposed Rulemaking is held; or 2) at the end of the time for submission of comments to the agency. During this period, the agency shall file with the secretary of state the order of rulemaking, either putting the proposed rule into effect, with or without further changes, or withdrawing the proposed rule.

RESPONSE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: As a result of this comment, the rule purpose has been updated to add this statement.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: One (1) staff comment was received. No other comments were received.

COMMENT #1: A staff member of the Office of Secretary of State noted that the purpose clause mistakenly included the phrase, "that

interfaces in real time with MCVR", which is inaccurate. The text of the rule itself does not include such language and is accurate. RESPONSE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: Staff agrees that this is an error and is removing the erroneous phrase.

**15 CSR 30-15.030 Initiative, Referendum, New Party, and Independent Candidate Petitions Missouri Voter Registration System and Other Computerized Processing Options**

*PURPOSE: The purpose of this rule is to clarify that local election authorities have the option to use the centralized Missouri Voter Registration System (MCVR) or a petition processing software program provided and maintained by the Office of the Secretary of State for initiative, referendum, new party, and independent candidate petition signature verification as allowed under Chapters 115 and 116, RSMo. MCVR is the official statewide voter registration list which was created and implemented as part of the Help America Vote Act of 2002. This system is maintained and administered by the Office of the Secretary of State and contains the name and registration information of every legally registered Missouri voter. It serves as the official voter registration list for the conduct of all elections in Missouri and allows local election authorities immediate real-time electronic access to the information contained in the system. Currently, local election authorities may use this system for petition signature verification as authorized by Chapter 115, RSMo. The secretary of state may make rules to ensure uniform, complete, and accurate checking of initiative and referendum petition signatures.*

RESPONSE: The department agrees with the staff comment. As a result, the text “2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV)” will be changed to “Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)” in order to align with the medical and scientific communities.

- Anthrax
- Botulism
- Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)
- Paralytic poliomyelitis
- Plague
- Rabies (Human)
- Ricin toxin
- Severe Acute Respiratory syndromeassociated Coronavirus (SARS-CoV) Disease
- Smallpox
- Tularemia (suspected intentional release)

Viral hemorrhagic fevers, suspected intentional (e.g., Viral hemorrhagic fever diseases: Ebola, Marburg, Lassa, Lujo, new world Arenavirus (Guanarito, Machupo, Junin, and Sabia viruses), or Crimean-Congo);

**7 CSR 10-6.040(6) Outdoor Advertising in Zoned and Unzoned  
Commercial and Industrial Areas**

*ACTION TAKEN: This NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OF RULE 7 CSR 10-6.040(6) will encourage industry attempts to convey advertising information to the travelling public about the availability of gasoline and food which is of importance for the continuity of essential services during the public emergency and for building the economic recovery thereafter by suspending the imposition of a moratorium on the issuance of new outdoor advertising permits for sections of highways scheduled for construction or reconstruction. This suspension only pertains to section (6) of the rule 7 CSR 10-6.040.*

*EMERGENCY STATEMENT: Pursuant to Executive Order (EO) 20-04 dated March 18, 2020, and EO 20-10 dated May 4, 2020, the rule is suspended effective May 7, 2020 until June 15, 2020.*

**NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OF RULE**

**10 CSR 10-2.330 Control of Gasoline Reid Vapor Pressure**

*ACTION TAKEN: This NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OF RULE 10 CSR 10-2.330 applies to the entirety of 10 CSR 10-2.330. 10 CSR 10-2.330 imposes certain volatility limits on gasoline intended for final use that is sold, dispensed, supplied, offered for sale or supply, transported or exchanged for trade in Clay, Platte, and Jackson Counties from June 1 through September 15 of each year. During the applicable time frame, the Reid Vapor Pressure (RVP) limit must be 7.0 psi or less. The COVID-19 emergency has caused a dramatic and unexpected decrease in the demand for gasoline, which is preventing regulated parties upstream of retailers and wholesale purchaser-consumers from selling the winter gasoline in their storage tanks and turning their storage tanks over to compliant low-volatility gasoline before June 1, 2020. Without a waiver of the low-volatility requirements, these regulated parties would be required to hold their winter*

*gasoline supply, which would prevent them from utilizing their storage tanks for low-volatility gasoline and result in a shortage of compliant low-volatility gasoline. These supply shortages are alleviated by this temporary suspension of 10 CSR 10-2.330.*

*This suspension is not anticipated to interfere with attainment of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards for ozone.*

*EMERGENCY STATEMENT: Pursuant to Executive Orders (EO) 20-04 dated March 18, 2020, and EO 20-09 dated April 24, 2020, the rule is suspended effective May 6, 2020 until June 15, 2020.*

Each claim should include the following information: the name, address and telephone number of the claimant; the amount of the claim; the basis for the claim; documentation supporting the claim; and the date(s) on which the event(s) on which the claim is based occurred.

Any and all claims against Lanfran, Inc. will be barred unless a proceeding to enforce such claim is commenced within two (2) years after the date this notice is published.

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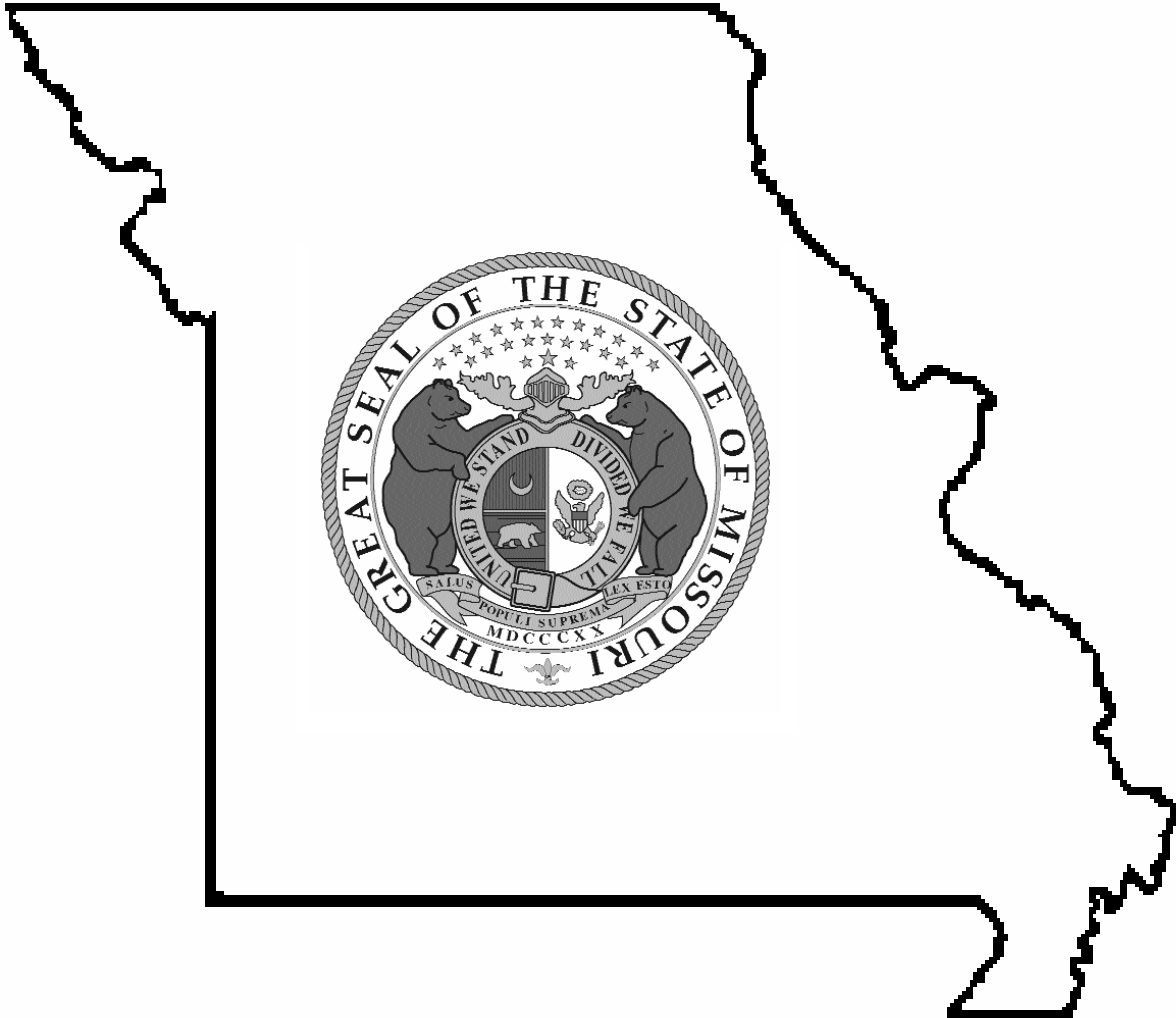
