

**T**his section will contain the final text of the rules proposed by agencies. The order of rulemaking is required to contain a citation to the legal authority upon which the order or rulemaking is based; reference to the date and page or pages where the notice of proposed rulemaking was published in the *Missouri Register*; an explanation of any change between the text of the rule as contained in the notice of proposed rulemaking and the text of the rule as finally adopted, together with the reason for any such change; and the full text of any section or subsection of the rule as adopted which has been changed from that contained in the notice of proposed rulemaking. During this period, the agency shall file with the secretary of state the order of rulemaking, either putting the proposed rule into effect, with or without further changes, or withdrawing the proposed rule.

No changes have been made in the text of the proposed amendment, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed amendment becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: The Department of Agriculture (MDA) received four (4) comments on the proposed amendment.

COMMENT #1: "It has been brought to my attention that the fees for plant pest inspections will be increasing from \$50 to \$125 this coming year. I would just like to state that I think a 2 1/2 times increase is a bit much at one time and would like to propose the fee going to just \$100 in this coming year. Thank you for your time."

RESPONSE: This rulemaking is recommended by the 2018 Joint Committee on Plant Industries fees, comprised of Senate and House agricultural leaders and representatives from leading agricultural associations representing large and small businesses. No changes have been made to the proposed amendment as result of this comment.

COMMENT #2: "For a small nursery like mine this quite an increase in cost from 35\$ to 75\$. I understand why for the increase but it increases my costs. Thanks for the input."

RESPONSE: This rulemaking is recommended by the 2018 Joint Committee on Plant Industries fees, comprised of Senate and House agricultural leaders and representatives from leading agricultural associations representing large and small businesses. No changes have been made to the proposed amendment as result of this comment.

COMMENT #3: "Fee increase for Nursery Dealer is 150%. This is too high and does not appear to be proportional to other fee increases. An increase is understandable, but should be in proportion to all others."

RESPONSE: This rulemaking is recommended by the 2018 Joint Committee on Plant Industries fees, comprised of Senate and House agricultural leaders and representatives from leading agricultural associations representing large and small businesses. No changes have been made to the proposed amendment as result of this comment.

COMMENT #4: "As an exporter we understand that things cost, and we feel that the Phyto inspections of \$50.00 for the first hour and

\$40.00 every hour there after is reasonable if starting time starts as soon as they arrive. State and Federal phytosanitary certificates at \$50.00 each is high we feel just to print out a piece of paper. We could live with \$25.00 or less for this service due to the fact that it is a standard form and it should not cost more than an inspection to print out. We are trying to keep costs down as much as possible in order to keep our market fair for everyone also.”

RESPONSE: This rulemaking is recommended by the 2018 Joint Committee on Plant Industries fees, comprised of Senate and House agricultural leaders and representatives from leading agricultural associations representing large and small businesses. No changes have been made to the proposed amendment as result of this comment.

No changes have been made in the text of the proposed amendment, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed amendment becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: The Weights, Measures and Consumer Protection Division received ten (10) comments on the proposed amendment.

COMMENTS #1-#7: Micah Lehenbauer, Monroe City, MO; Brian Pasbrig, Show Me Ethanol, LLC, Carrollton, MO; Mike Moreland, Missouri Corn Growers, Jefferson City, MO; Steve Murphy, Missouri Renewable Fuels Association, Jefferson City, MO; Chris Bliley, Growth Energy, Washington, DC; Michael Walz, POET, LLC, Washington, D.C.; and Kristin Moore, Growth Energy, Washington, D.C. provided letters of support for the proposed amendments.

RESPONSE: No changes have been made to the proposed amend-

ment as a result of these comments.

COMMENT #8: Karen Clawson, Mid-America Regional Council, Kansas City, MO expressed concern with any incremental increase in transportation emissions and requested the state work with MARC and the Air Quality Forum to provide greater air quality benefits to the Kansas City region.

RESPONSE: No changes have been made to the proposed amendment as a result of this comment.

COMMENT #9: Dan Bowerson, Alliance for Automotive Innovation, Washington, DC requested Missouri adopt the latest ASTM D4814 standard as written.

RESPONSE: Work on gasoline volatility is ongoing at ASTM International. It is the department's expectation that fuel producers, automobile manufacturers, pipeline representatives, and petroleum marketers will find common ground by addressing volatility specifications for gasoline at ASTM International. Therefore, the department will continue the exemption until such time ASTM addresses the volatility of ethanol blended fuels greater than ten percent (10%). No changes have been made to the proposed amendment as a result of this comment.

COMMENT #10: Ron Leone, Missouri Petroleum Marketers & Convenience Store Association, Jefferson City, MO expressed concerns with consumer misfueling liability and gas station equipment compatibility for stations and convenience stores who choose to sell blends greater than E10.

RESPONSE: Marketing E15 is not mandatory and E15 is currently being sold throughout the state. A retailer or wholesaler who chooses to market E15 will be required to have compatible equipment to dispense this fuel. This proposal will provide more flexibility in marketing E15 year-round. No changes have been made to the proposed amendment as a result of this comment.
