### Scope and Content

This series contains certificates of service awards; they include meritorious service medals, conspicuous service medals, legion of merit medals, certificates of appreciation, and promotions. Per Missouri Revised Statute 41.560, meritorious service medals are given “to individuals who have done and performed valorous or meritorious military service which reflects honorably and creditably upon the state of Missouri.” Per Missouri Revised Statute 41.570, conspicuous service medals are given “to individuals designated by [the governor] who have done and performed distinguished and conspicuous service or services either civil or military which reflect honorably and creditably upon the state of Missouri.” Certificates of appreciation and promotions are awarded to members of the Missouri National Guard.

Date filed can be many months after the date signed, so check the succeeding year if not found in the year signed.
