Historical and Biographical Notes

Norma Champion was born January 21, 1933 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. From 1957-1986, Champion was the writer, producer, and host of *Children's Hour* and a commercial announcer at KYTV. She earned a Master of Arts in Communication from Southwest Missouri State University and a PhD in Education Communications Technology from the University of Oklahoma. She continued post-graduate work at Wheaton College, University of London, and Netherlands Broadcasting System. She was a professor of Broadcasting and Communication Theory at Evangel College. In 1994, her husband, Rev. Richard Champion, died. They had two children, Jeffrey and Brooke. In 2012, she married Michael Gollub.

Champion served in the Missouri House of Representatives from 1993-2000 and the Missouri Senate from 2003-2011. She served as the vice chair and chair of the Seniors, Families and Public Health Committee. In 2005, Champion was part of the filibuster to change the name of Southwest Missouri State University to Missouri State University.
