
Claims to French and Spanish Land Grants



Survey map, La Saline Salt Works, near Ste. Genevieve, 1806.

Henry Peyroux received a land grant of 9,077 arpents or 7,760 acres in 1787. His land was along the Mississippi River and both sides of the Saline Creek in the Ste. Genevieve district. The land grant included a salt works that is shown on the map. The United States Government approved a survey of the property in 1806. The first land board refused Henry Peyroux's claim. The second land board approved Peyroux's ownership in 1834, almost 50 years after the land was first granted.
