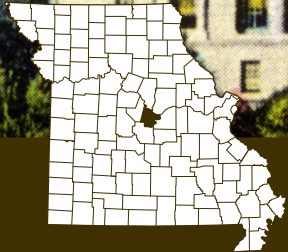
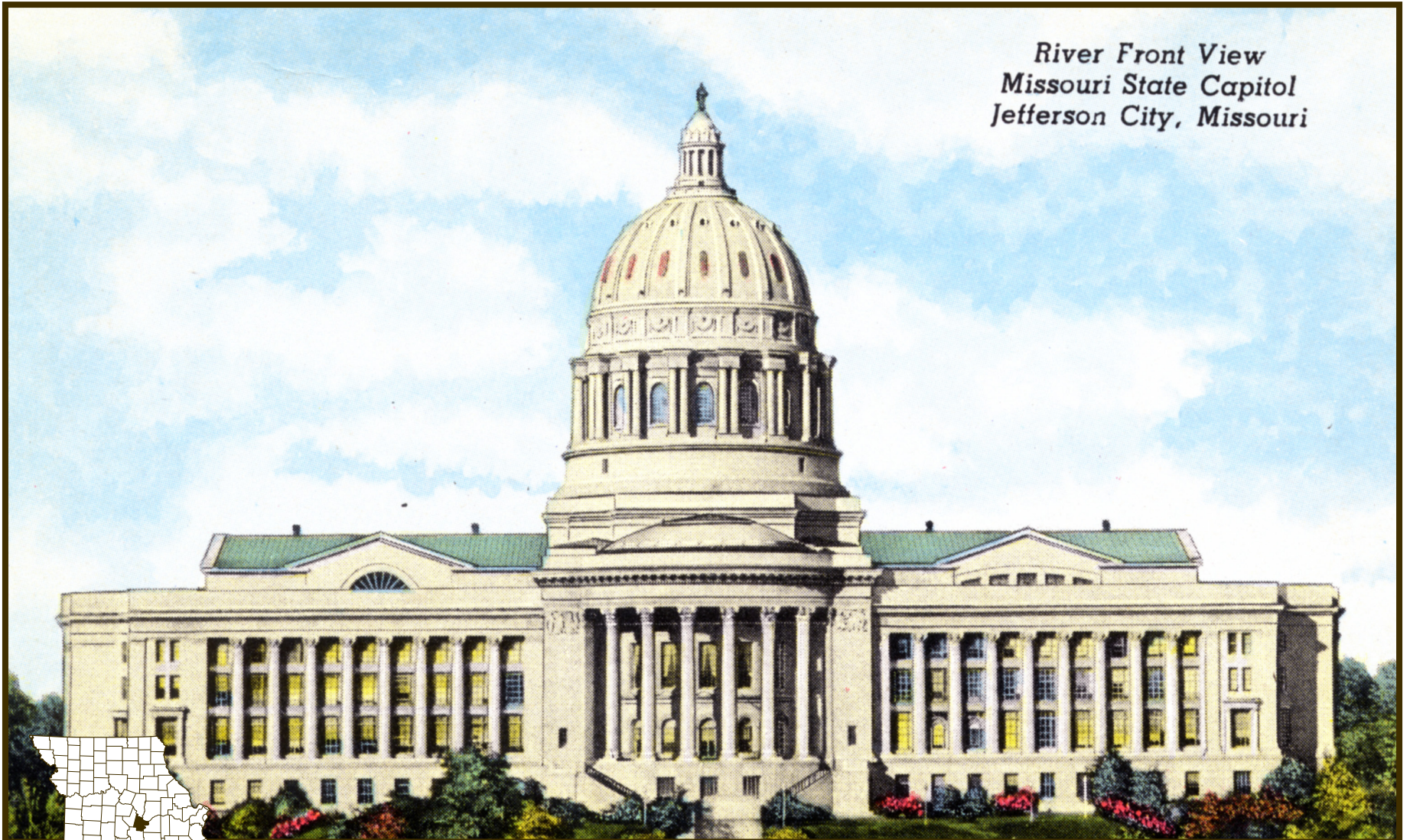

The Missouri State Capitol is located in Jefferson City at 201 West Capitol Avenue. The domed building was completed in 1917. It is the third capitol building in Jefferson City. In addition to housing the Missouri General Assembly, the Capitol houses offices for the governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state, state treasurer, state auditor and some administrative agencies. This image shows the side of the capitol that faces the Missouri River.
