Historical and Biographical Notes

Wilson Bell was born on May 24, 1897 in Potosi, Missouri. He attended the University of Missouri, Columbia. He enlisted in the Army on August 15, 1918 and served in the United States Army. He served as the treasurer of Washington County, and was active in the Democratic Party. Wilson Bell edited and published *The Independent-Journal*. In 1940 he was elected to the State Treasurer's Office. He was elected as Secretary of State

in 1944. Wilson Bell died while serving his only term as Secretary of State on May 20, 1947. He was succeeded in office by Edgar C. Nelson

Wilson Bell married Margaret Mary Settle in 1918. The couple had two daughters. Margaret Bell died on February 20, 1971.
