HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Edgar Chilton Nelson was born on August 17, 1883 near Bunceton, Missouri. He joined his brothers in the newspaper business with the publication of *The Bunceton Weekly Eagle*. He also acquired *The Boonville Advertiser*, *The Boonville Daily News*, *The Linn County News*, and *The Blade and Messenger*.

In 1933 Governor Park appointed Edgar C. Nelson chairman of the Missouri Workmen's Compensation Commission. Governor Donnelly appointed Edgar C. Nelson as Secretary of State after the death of Wilson Bell. Edgar C. Nelson did not run for election in 1948, and was replaced by Walter Toberman.

Edgar C. Nelson married Celeste Allison Chamberlain on January 16, 1912. The couple had one daughter, Mrs. T. A. Duckworth. Celeste Nelson died on July 12, 1955 in Boonville, Missouri. Edgar C. Nelson died on September 9, 1970 in Wausau, Wisconsin, where he was living with his daughter.
