HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Established in 1891 (Laws 1891, p. 16) the Board of Fund Commissioners directs the payment of interest on state debt, issues, redeems and cancels state general obligation bonds, and performs other administrative acts required by law. The board originally consisted of the governor, attorney general, state auditor and state treasurer, with the governor as president and the state treasurer as secretary.

The Board of Fund Commissioners was originally located within the treasury department. In 1945, the board moved to the newly created Department of Revenue (Laws 1945, p. 1428), and the director of revenue was added to the board. In 1977, the director of revenue was replaced on the board by the commissioner of administration (Laws 1977, p. 150). The lieutenant governor was added to the board in 1992 (Laws 1992, p. 1238) and the state auditor was removed in 2013 (Laws 2013, p. 312).

2013	HB 116 removed the state auditor from the Board of Fund Commissioners (Laws		
	2013, p. 312).
