Historical and Biographical Notes

The Water Pollution Board was established by Governor James T. Blair on April 15, 1958, to administer the State Water Pollution Law (Chapter 204 RSMo. 1959). The Board was to cooperate with the federal government and governments of surrounding states or states with shared waterways, including managing federal grant funds within Missouri. In the early years, the Board focused on developing water quality objectives and reducing river pollution, especially regarding rivers used for public water supplies.

During the 1960s, the Board was extremely productive setting standards. In 1967 the water quality standards for interstate streams (those connected with other states) was federally approved. The following year, the standards for intrastate streams (those only within Missouri) were also approved. In addition, it was determined that all plans for sewage and industrial waster must be approved and prioritized by the Board.

In 1972, the Board was renamed the Clean Water Commission after the new Clean Water Law (Chapter 204, RSMo. Supp. 1972) went into effect. This expansion of the law granted the commission the powers to monitor water quality; manage water quality planning; conduct comprehensive stream and pollution surveys; create a network for reporting/cleaning accidental waste spills; issue permits for agricultural, industrial, and municipal waste sources, sewers, and sewage treatment facilities; conduct investigations; provide technical assistance; and enforce the new law. In addition, the Commission would investigate the major West Plains Sewage Spill that occurred in 1978 that effected waterways in southern Missouri and northern Arkansas.

At the federal level, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) was established in 1970 and the Clean Water Act (officially the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972; 33 U.S.C. §1251 et seq. (1972)/P.L. 92-500) was enacted to replace the earlier Federal Water Pollution Control Act. This was followed by the Clean Water Act of 1977 (P.L. 95-217). The Clean Water Commission received financial assistance from the EPA that was passed along in the form of grants and other financial assistance to local governments and businesses. The Water Quality Act (WQA; P.L. 100-4) followed in 1987.

When originally founded, the Commission had six governor-appointed members with one member each chosen from specific industries. In 2002, SB 708 revised the membership of the commission to seven members and issued new standards about whom to include. Two members must be knowledgeable about agricultural, industrial, or mining needs. One member must be knowledgeable about the needs of public wastewater treatment facilities. The remaining members are from the general public. Each member serves a four-year term instead of the previous six-year term.

In addition to the Commission, sister programs within the Department of Natural Resources' Division of Environmental Quality include the Water Protection Program, the Soil and Water Conservation Program, and the Safe Drinking Water Commission.

Scope and Content

These records cover appeals and variance requests submitted to the Clean Water Commission. Appeals are typically for variance requests that were not granted. Appeals cases, depending on how the Commission originally filed them, could be in this series or the Hearings series (cases filed in Hearings typically lack the legal paperwork). Significant cases include Lake City Army Ammunition Plant, Schuylkill Metal Corp., Carriage Oaks Housing Development, and Amoco Oil, Anthony Sansone, and Concord Car Wash.

Cases were typically filed numerically by assigned two- or three-digit case number followed by the case name. Variance requests that were granted by the Commission are filed as "CWC-V [two digit year abbreviation]-[month]" followed by the case name.

Note that due to the nature of the documents and their original file order it is possible that documents on a topic could be split between the three main series: Minutes, Hearings, and Appeals.

Oversized items are listed below and are also listed on the Oversized Collections Index. "M.C." in the table below stands for "Map Cabinet."

Scope and Content

Collection includes hearings beginning in 1963. Hearings occurred on special topics of interest, such as the state of streams, especially when the commission newly-formed. Many hearings, especially more recent ones, were focused on updating rules or hearing appeals for rejected permits. Each hearing includes a transcript. Many hearings include additional material, including exhibits, planning documents, related correspondence and comments, etc. Exhibit materials can include correspondence, audiovisual materials, maps, reports, studies, survey results, and other relevant information.

Major hearings include the 1970s Basin Plans for all major river basins in the state, including both regional and statewide hearings; the Big Piney River hearings covering from the late 1960s through the mid-1970s; the West Plains Sewage Spill Case from 1978, which affected both southern Missouri and northern Arkansas; and the Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFO) hearings of the 1990s, especially the 1996 hearing which generated the most public comments of any hearing held by the Clean Water Commission within these records.

It is important to note the following:

- Some hearings from 1974-1978 have been water damaged, but are fully readable.
- Some hearings are missing exhibits mentioned within the transcripts.
- Some hearings lack transcripts, and those instances are noted below.
- If hearings included a large amount of legal documents, the Commission filed those with the “Appeals” series.
- Photographs within this series predominately feature Jefferson County due to the Oakwood Terrace and Rock Creek Watershed cases being the most imaged cases.

Note that due to the nature of the documents and their original file order it is possible that documents on a topic could be split between the three main series: Minutes, Hearings, and Appeals. Additionally, one box of records went missing in transit to the Missouri State Archives and it is suspected to contain hearings and appeals from 1997 and 1998.

Oversized items are listed below and are also listed on the Oversized Collections Index. “M.C.” in the table below stands for “Map Cabinet.”

Scope and Content

Collection includes minutes beginning in 1959. From June, 1979, onwards, each meeting had an accompanying packet. These packets have been included within the “Minutes” series after the minutes in the files. The packets include documents under discussion including those related to funding, grant increases and requests, data tables, and final rulings on variances, hearings, and appeals. Also included as “Minutes, Related documents,” are items related to specific meetings not included in the packets. These items can include correspondence, additional documents related to items under discussions, photos, maps, diagrams, data tables, bound volumes, reports, and presentation materials.

Some major reports were filed either as part of the meeting packets or the related materials. These include the *Missouri Nonpoint Sources Annual Reports* for 1995, 1996, and 1999; *Continuing Planning Process for Water Quality Management 2001-2005*; grant reports; intended use reports; and funding reports.

Conference call meetings do not include packets. Some in-person meetings are missing packets, as noted in the table below. The July 1993, meeting includes the packet and related documents, but no minutes, likely due to the 1993 Flood blocking travel to the planned meeting location.

Due to the nature of the documents and their original file order it is possible that documents prior to 2002 on a topic could be split between the three main series: Minutes, Hearings, and Appeals. On the documents from 2009 onwards, the Clean Water Commission started filing all documents as part of their minutes, so hearing, appeal, and variance information will be found within the minutes. Minutes covering 2003-2008 have not yet been received by the Missouri State Archives.

Additionally, one box of records from 2009-2011 went missing in transit to the Missouri State Archives.

Oversized items are listed below and are also listed on the Oversized Collections Index. “M.C.” in the table below stands for “Map Cabinet.”
