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Historical and Biographical Notes

Created in 1965 by the Missouri General Assembly, the Missouri Air Conservation Commission (MACC) was originally known as the Air Pollution Protection Program

(*Laws 1965*, p. 851). MACC is charged with supervising the administration and enforcement of the Missouri Air Conservation Law (2025 643.010-650 RSMo). When it was first created as the Air Pollution Protection Program, MACC was assigned to the Missouri Department of Public Health. As part of the Omnibus State Reorganization Act of 1974, it was moved into the newly created Department of Natural Resources and renamed to MACC (*Laws 1974*, p. 530).

According to MACC's 2024 website,

“The commission adopts, amends and rescinds rules related to air quality. In coordination with industry, citizens and delegated local governments, the commission develops strategies to ensure statewide compliance with federal air quality standards and reduce concentrations of pollutants to safe levels in nonattainment areas. The commission makes decisions on appeals from enforcement orders and permit conditions. When necessary, the commission also begins legal actions to ensure compliance with Missouri Air Conservation Law and rules.”

MACC meetings may include public hearings, actions on rules, requests for variances, or work-related compliance issues. Most meetings occur in Jefferson City, but meetings do occur in other major cities statewide, such as the St. Louis, Kansas City, and Springfield metropolitan areas.

Timeline

Year	Event
1965-1966	The Air Pollution Protection Program created by the 1965 session House Bill 6, approved and made effective on May 24, 1966.
1974	The Air Pollution Protection Program renamed to the Missouri Air Conservation Commission and transferred to the Department of Natural Resources as part of the Omnibus State Reorganization Act of 1974 (Senate Bill 1) approved on February 13, 1974 and made effective on May 2, 1974.

Scope and Content

The Public Hearings series contains records related to the public hearings of the Air Conservation Commission, including those under the commission's previous names. Records may include transcripts, correspondence, and exhibits. Some exhibits include newspaper publication affidavits, mailing lists, certified mail returns, draft plans, and written testimony. Some 1993-1995 hearings were given topical names in addition to dates.

From 1966 to 1981 the records exist exclusively on microfilm. All microfilm (1966-1994) has been scanned and is available on DVD in Reference.
