HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

John Leo Sullivan (1877-1936) was Missouri Secretary of State from 1917-1921. Sullivan hailed from Sedalia, Pettis County, Missouri where he served as Collector from 1906-1914. He was elected Secretary of State as a Democrat in November 1916 and served one term. Sullivan ran for re-election in 1920 but was defeated by Charles U. Becker. He and his wife Mary had five children.
