### HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

The Jefferson City chapter of the Business and Professional Women's Club was formed on February 24, 1941. The mission of the Club was "to promote the interests of business and professional women, to bring about a spirit of cooperation and to extend their opportunities." (quoted from the Constitution, Article II)

The Club's first president was Norma Richter. The Club got its start from the same group in Columbia, Missouri, who served as mentors to the Jefferson City members. Later, in 1948, the Jefferson City Club was able to mentor a new club of its own: Eldon, Missouri. In its early

years, the Club had a “loan closet” established in memory of Laura Layher who was a nurse. The loans were for medical equipment and were extended to members of the community in need.
