HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

These images were donated to the Archives by Paul N. Doll of Jefferson City in 1997. Doll was born in Caldwell County in 1911, the son of Ernest Easton Doll and Emma Louise (Colby) Doll. Throughout his life he lived in Hamilton (Caldwell County), St. Louis City, Columbia and Jefferson City. Doll worked as a professional engineer and received his bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of Missouri-Columbia. He was well known by legislators in Missouri because of his work as a lobbyist for the University of Missouri. US Rep. Ike Skelton presented a message to the US House of Representatives on May 25, 1999 as a tribute to Doll who died on May 8 of that year.
