Scope and Content

These are binders of information sheets on historic sites in Jefferson City. Each binder contains an index in the front of the first binder in each district that is arranged by street name and street number as well as a map showing where the particular district is located. Each address's architectural/historic inventory survey sheet includes questions on the type of architecture, building materials, date built and by whom (if known), and status as protected or not. Some sheets also include a 3½" x 5" photograph of the property.

These records have not been processed and have been kept in the lender's original order per their request.

The date in the table below comes from the date the index was made; sheets inside the binder are often a year or two older.
