HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

John Mark Graham (1894-1983) received his engineering education from the University of Texas. From March 1922 through January 1926, Graham worked for the Missouri Highway Commission as a Design and Project Engineer. He was assigned to the Missouri River bridges in Boonville and Glasgow as well as an overpass bridge east of St. Joseph. Graham took photographs of these construction projects and others. After he left the Missouri Highway Commission in 1926, he worked in Tennessee, Ohio, and Texas.
