Accession #2017-0030

Commerce Banks of Missouri commissioned Jack O'Hara to make twelve paintings of Missouri scenes in 1973. The prints were then sold to the public in sets of four. The "Impressions of Missouri" collection contains eight of O'Hara's prints comprising Set I and Set III.

APPENDIX

Several other items have been donated by State Archivist John Dougan and originally accessioned as part of MS368. These items have since been transferred to other record groups with the donor's approval. See below.

- 2) A 68-page booklet One Hundred Years: The Tuesday Club, Jefferson City, Missouri, 1895-1995 was transferred to the Cole County history collection in Reference on 03/25/2011. Accession #2011-0058.
- 3) Twenty postcards from around Missouri were transferred to MS460 Missouri Postcards on or around 09/13/2016. MS460 was dissolved on 09/07/2017 and combined with MS398 Missouri Postcards, which is where these 20 cards are now. Accession #2013-0040.
- 4) Two maps published by the MO Department of Conservation ("Missouri Trout Fishing" and "Discover Outdoor Missouri") were transferred to RG000.103 Department of Conservation State Documents on 09/07/2017. Accession #2014-0159. Map Cabinet M Drawer 5 Folder 4.
- 5) Two postcards of Missouri state institutions (Chillicothe Industrial Home for Girls and St. Joseph State Asylum) were transferred to MS460 Missouri Postcards on or around 09/13/2016. MS460 was dissolved on 09/07/2017 and combined with MS398 Missouri Postcards, which is where these cards are now. Accession #2016-0137.
- 6) All of #2017-0004 was assigned to the State Documents collection. State documents re the 100th anniversary of the Capitol Capstone Ceremony, the Missouri State Capitol Centennial Celebration, Gov. Eric Greitens' Inauguration Ceremony, blank seals from Kander's administration, and one publication on the Center for Missouri Studies. All documents moved to the State Documents Collections: 1) Misc. Commissions finding aid for the Capitol Commission anniversary docs, 2) Governors' State Docs for the Greitens material, 3) SOS state docs for the blank great seals with SOS Kander's signature, and 4) the Center for MO Studies document was placed in SHSM State Documents.
