BIOGRAPHICAL AND HISTORICAL INFORMATION

Missouri Governor Herbert S. Hadley took several river expeditions to the Ozark region of Missouri during his tenure. He and his entourage travelled down the White River, Current River, and St. Francois. This collection includes images from his Current River expedition. The trips were part of his plans to create the Game and Fish Commission, a waterways commission, and land reclamation initiatives.

Scope and Content

These are copy prints made in 2000 from two photo album originals loaned to the Archives by the donor. The first includes images of Maryville, Missouri, its resident W.C. "Calvin" Pierce, and his politician guests. The second album features images of Governor Herbert Hadley's expedition down the Current River in October 1909 intended to study the waterways and potential for a timber industry.

All images have been digitized as TIFFs and are available on Manuscript DVD #7 in Reference.
