Missouri State Veterinarian Ledger, 1889-1893

### Scope and Content

Appointed in 1884 to the faculty of the Missouri State University, now the University of Missouri, Department of Agriculture, Paul Paquin, D.V.M. taught veterinary science. In 1885, he was appointed the first Missouri state veterinarian, a joint state/university position. Paquin studied with Louis Pasteur in France in 1886 where he prepared vaccines against smallpox, fowl and hog cholera, anthrax, and rabies. He obtained his M.D. from the University of Missouri upon his return from France and in 1887 he founded the pathology and hygiene laboratories. Paquin successfully halted an anthrax outbreak in Vernon County in 1887 through the use of vaccines and quarantines. He established an agricultural research station on an isolated farm south of Hallsville where he researched Texas Fever by studying 18 infected longhorns that had been transferred by train to Columbia (with special permissions). Paquin resigned in 1891 and practiced medicine in Michigan and North Carolina before returning to Missouri as a public health physician. He died in Kansas City in 1916. Dr. T.J. Turner succeeded Paquin in 1891 as the second state veterinarian.

The Missouri State Veterinarian Ledger, 1889-1893 contains information on the early practice of veterinary medicine. Occupational details and travel expenses for doctors Paquin, Turner and their associates comprise the ledger. The volume also contains log entries detailing owner, location of visits, animals, nature of diseases, characteristic symptoms, and treatments; quarantine regulations pertaining to the Texas cattle fever outbreaks of 1890, 1892, and 1893; and financial reports submitted by deputy state veterinarians and livestock inspectors.

This ledger was loaned to the Archives in 2016 by the Missouri Veterinary Medical Association for digitizing. The donor retained the original volume. JPEG2000 scans of the volume are available on Missouri Digital Heritage online here:
