HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

The Hurlbut Undertaking and Embalming Company, credited with being the oldest mortuary in Joplin, was started by William K. Hurlbut, a native of Eldorado, Wisconsin who moved to Missouri with his family in 1869. Hurlbut moved to Joplin in 1903. The Hurlbut Mortuary was incorporated in 1905 with a paid-up capital stock of ten thousand dollars. William's wife Grace was named president, their son Perry K. Hurlbut vice president, and William himself was appointed secretary and treasurer. In 1914, the company became the first in Jasper County to use

a motor-driven hearse. In 1948 the building was sold to the Salvation Army and the historic Charles Schifferdecker house at 422 Sergeant became the new site of the mortuary. Around this time Newell Hurlbut sold his interest in the business to Dale Glover, whereupon the business became the Hurlbut-Glover Mortuary with Glover acting as president and Perry Hurlbut as vice president. In the early 1950s the mortuary moved to 731 Wall where it remained until the business closed in 1969.
