BIOGRAPHICAL AND HISTORICAL INFORMATION

Zeal S. Wright (1928-2004) and his wife Betty (1928-2001) started Wright Studio and Camera Shop in the fall of 1954 in Jefferson City. Zeal Wright had previous experience as a photographer for the University of Missouri and for Hammond and Irwin Studio in Jefferson City. The Wrights' business was a success and was officially incorporated on June 3, 1958. Eleven years later the name was changed to Wright Studio, Inc.

Zeal was the primary photographer for the company and focused on portraits and shots of Jefferson City. He was hired many times to be the official portrait photographer for state

employees, and those photographs would be published in the Official Manual for the State of Missouri, aka “Blue Book.”

The Wrights’ son Randall is also a photographer. He contributed about three dozen flood photographs to this collection. The Studio was dissolved in 2005.

Scope and Content

Inmates of the Missouri State Penitentiary (MSP) rioted and took guards hostage on the night of September 22-23, 1954. Fires in multiple buildings broke out as a result of the rioting, and four prisoners were killed. These images primarily document the damage done to the buildings of the MSP. The photographs are 4"x6" with corresponding 4"x5" copy negatives.

[NOTE: These images were originally donated by Dr. Joseph Summers and were part of his manuscript collection MS433. In early 2018, the images were transferred to MS475 Wright Studios Photograph Collection and permission was granted by the Wright family for reproduction.]

Scope and Content

In July 1993, the Missouri River crested at its highest-ever recorded level in Jefferson City: 38.6 feet. Anything above 23 feet is considered flood stage. Many structures were damaged by the floodwaters. This photograph series was taken by Randall Wright from the Capitol Building looking in every direction.

The 12"x8" photograph exists as a digital scan and is on Manuscript DVD #7 in Reference. It is also on the Z Drive. The 34 images in Box 203 are not digitized.
