### HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Henry Schrader (1837-1892) was a resident of Rich Fountain in Osage County, Missouri. He was born in Hanover, Germany as Heinrich Schrader and immigrated to the United States in 1854. He married Wilhelmine Schrey (1838-1869) on 06/15/1858 and they had five children together. Schrader worked at first as a farmer, then a merchant and postmaster. After his first wife's death, he married a woman named Mary (1829-1885). His third wife was Maria (1847-1907).
