HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

The Sanborn Map Company was founded in New York in 1867 by Daniel Alfred Sanborn (1827-1883) under the name D.A. Sanborn National Insurance Diagram Bureau. Sanborn was a mapmaker who pioneered the idea of fire insurance maps using color-coding to indicate building materials. Based on the maps, insurance company actuaries would evaluate the risk of fire and write their policies accordingly. The maps have historical value beyond building materials as they provide locations by name of businesses, schools, government agencies and more.
