Historical and Biographical Notes

Missouri Earth Advocate was a publication originating with the Missouri Friends of the Earth (MoFOE) chapter, which was the first state chapter of the national FOE organization. According to the first issue in November 1974, MoFOE "was born out of a need to establish a strong state oriented network of environmentalists to counter the barrage of projects designed to satisfy the needs of some at the expense of thousands of others." (p. 1) The group was focused on environmental issues affecting Missouri.

Missouri Earth Advocate was a monthly newspaper (later quarterly) distributed to MoFOE members and other subscribers for \$0.25 per issue. Articles focused on strip mining, nuclear power, water pollution, highway and dam construction, land use, and more. For example, several issues have numerous articles opposing a proposed Meramec River dam.

MoFOE and *Missouri Earth Advocate* strongly encouraged working with (or against, as the case may be) the state legislature and local governments. According to Vol. 1 No. 1, "To date, [MoFOE has] been involved in an air pollution variance fight in Columbia (a win), steel vs. lead shot hearings in St. Louis, nuclear power hearings in Jefferson City, [and] Project Independence hearings in Kansas City. ... We will be actively campaigning in support of the 1975 bill calling for a ban on non-returnable containers in Missouri." (p. 1)

Scope and Content

Missouri Earth Advocate was a monthly publication (later quarterly) containing articles, black and white photographs, and illustrations of environmental issues affecting Missouri. Starting with the Spring 1982 issue, the newspaper received a title change and expanded its distribution beyond Missouri to include Nebraska, Kansas, Illinois, and Indiana. The paper frequently contained inserts of related publications as special supplements, such as *Sho-Me Water* and *Missouri River Journal*.
