### **Historical and Biographical Notes**

Cornelius Roach was born on August 9, 1863 in Jersey County, Illinois. He taught school and was a principal in Fidelity, Illinois. He moved to Carthage, Missouri in 1890 and

published the *Jasper County Democrat*. He served as the secretary of the senate from 1893 to 1907. In 1900 Governor Stephens appointed Cornelius Roach to the Missouri Pan American Commission. He ran for Secretary of State as a Democrat in 1908 and was elected. He was reelected in 1912. In 1916 Cornelius Roach ran for Governor but was defeated in the primaries by Frederick Gardner. After leaving office in 1917, Cornelius Roach moved to Kansas City and worked in the banking industry.

Cornelius Roach married Anna Bell McClure on June 13, 1889 in Jerseyville, Illinois. The couple had three children. Anna Roach died on October 13, 1895. Cornelius Roach married Sallie Elizabeth Millard on June 8, 1897 in Carthage, Missouri. The couple had nine children. Cornelius Roach died on September 3, 1934 in Kansas City, Missouri. Sallie Roach died on December 28, 1963 in Kansas City, Missouri.
