Historical and Biographical Notes

Born August 8, 1937, in St. Louis, Peter Wayne Goode, known as Wayne Goode, served as a Democrat in the Missouri House of Representatives (1962-1983) and Missouri Senate (1984-2005). He attended public schools in Normandy and received a Bachelor of

Science degree in banking and finance from the University of Missouri – Columbia. He married Jane Margaret Bell on July 27, 1963 and had two children, Peter Wayne III and Jennifer Jacquelyn. On October 3, 2020, Goode died of leukemia.

Often referred to as the “father of UMSL,” during his first term as Representative, Goode submitted a bill (House Bill 153) to allow the University of Missouri – St. Louis to be established.
