### HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

In 1972, the 76th Missouri General Assembly created the American Revolution Bicentennial Commission (ARBC) of Missouri with the adoption of House Bill 1559. It directs the commission to prepare an overall program for commemorating the bicentennial and to plan, encourage, develop and coordinate observances and activities associated with American independence.

The commission was composed of five members of the public appointed by the Governor, five State Senators appointed by the Senate President Pro Tem, and five State Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The chairman was Dr. William E. Parrish.
