HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

These records comprise the working papers and office files (1980-1996) maintained by Representative Mary Bland (Democrat), District 43, during eight terms of office. They were donated to the Missouri State Archives in December 1996 as Representative Bland prepared her office for a ninth term. She retired from the General Assembly in 2005 and passed away on February 19, 2016.

Representative Bland's legislative career includes service on the following committees: Public Health and Safety; Appropriations: Health & Mental Health; Higher Education; and Tourism, Recreational, and Cultural Affairs. Representative Bland was also involved in the Missouri Legislative Black Caucus and the National Black Caucus of State Legislators, having served as chairperson of the former and first vice chairperson of the latter.

Many of Representative Bland's papers concern minority issues, discrimination complaints, child welfare, and education.
