**Examples include:** Missouri driver license, Missouri nondriver license, U.S. Passport, military ID

I understand that my vote will not be counted unless: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) I return this polling place ballot between 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. and provide one of the following forms of identification:</li> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Nonexpired Missouri driver's license;</li> <li>(b) Nonexpired or nonexpiring Missouri nondriver's license;</li> <li>(c) A document that satisfies all of the following requirements:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i) The document contains my name in substantially the same form as the most recent signature on my voter registration record;</li> <li>ii) The document contains my photograph;</li> <li>iii) The document contains an expiration date and is not expired, or if expired, the document expires after the date of the most recent general election; and</li> <li>iv) The document was issued by the United States or the state of Missouri; or</li> <li>d) Identification containing my photograph issued to me by the Missouri National Guard, the United States Armed Forces, including Space Force, or the United States Department of Veteran Affairs as a member or former member of the Missouri National Guard or the United States Armed Forces that is not expired or does not have an expiration date; or</li> </ol></li></ul> <li>e) The election authority verifies my identity by comparing my signature on this envelope to the signature on file with the election authority and determines that I was eligible to cast a ballot at this polling place; and</li> <li>f) This provisional ballot otherwise qualifies to be counted under the laws of the state of Missouri.</li> </ol>

### Provisional ballot example

## There are two ways your vote counts:

1. If you come back to your polling place on election day and show a valid photo ID, your vote counts.
2. If your signature matches the signature in the voter registry, your vote counts.

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
