

It is a class A misdemeanor punishable, notwithstanding the provisions of section 560.021, RSMo, to the contrary, for a term of imprisonment not to exceed one year in the county jail or a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars or both, for anyone to sign any initiative petition with any name other than his or her own, or knowingly to sign his or her name more than once for the same measure for the same election, or to sign a petition when such person knows he or she is not a registered voter. NOTICE: The proposed amendment revises Article III of the Constitution by amending Section 39(e). You are advised that the proposed constitutional amendment may be interpreted to change, repeal, or modify by implication Article III, Sections 39 and 39(9) of this Constitution.

Be it resolved by the people of the state of Missouri that the Constitution be amended:

Section A. Article III of the Constitution is revised by amending Section 39(e) to read as follows:

Section 39(e). 1. The general assembly is authorized to permit upon the Mississippi and Missouri Rivers only, which shall include artificial spaces that contain water and that are within 1000 feet of the closest edge of the main channel of either of those rivers, lotteries, gift enterprises and games of chance to be conducted on excursion gambling boats and ~~[floating]~~ nonfloating facilities. Any license issued before or after the adoption date of this amendment for any excursion gambling boat or ~~[floating]~~ nonfloating facility located in any such ~~[artificial]~~ space shall be deemed to be authorized by the General Assembly and to be in compliance with this Section.

2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, lotteries, gift enterprises, and games of chance may be conducted upon the Osage River on a gambling boat and floating or nonfloating facilities licensed by the Missouri Gaming Commission, but only at the location that is supported and approved by the County Commission of Miller County, Missouri, in resolution 2025-217, and the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lake Ozark, Missouri, in resolution 2025R-32. Such location is also known as tax parcel number 129032000000001000, sections 29 and 32, township 40, range 15. Such support and approval are deemed to satisfy any and all current or future local approval requirements as set forth in chapter 313, RSMo. The Missouri Gaming Commission shall only issue one additional gambling boat license and such license shall only be issued to operate a gambling boat and floating or nonfloating facilities on the portion of the Osage River described herein. The additional license shall be operated consistent with all other Missouri laws applicable to any existing gambling boat and floating or nonfloating facilities operating in the state of Missouri, including the requirements to impose a tax on the adjusted gross receipts received from gambling games and remit fees to the state of Missouri and the local community in connection with such operation.
