PROPOSED AMENDMENT

15 CSR 30-100.010 Approval, Revocation and[/or] Suspension of Notary Commission. The secretary is amending the Chapter to remove the duplicative term, revising the title, and adding a subsection (3).

PURPOSE: This amendment updates the Chapter by removing the duplicative term "Secretary of State", adds "Approval" to the section and adds a new subsection.

(3) An individual who has been convicted of a felony involving dishonesty or moral turpitude, committed in the last five years, will be denied approval to be a commission.

AUTHORITY: section 486.605, RSMo 2020 and 486.385.2, RSMo 2016. Original rule filed Dec. 16, 1985, effective April 11, 1986. Amended; Filed April 17, 2017, effective Oct. 2017.*

PUBLIC COST: This proposed amendment will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

PRIVATE COST: This proposed amendment will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.
