






There are 365 tax-supported libraries in Missouri, compared to only 31 career centers. Libraries offer many services that help Missourians develop workforce skills.







## LIBRARY RESOURCES

To provide business and workforce development services, libraries require library staff, training facilitators, computers with strong internet connectivity, databases and meeting rooms.



## **COMPUTER USE**

Library patrons used public computers
4,601,200 times in 2018 for employment, to file taxes, complete homework, conduct research and other activities.



## LIBRARY VISITS

Public libraries had 48.9 million total in-person and online visitors in 2018. With a just under \$5.1 million in state funding for FY2019, the state spends 10¢ per library visit.
