IMLS Acknowledgement Requirements

Each and every LSTA grant issued by the Missouri State Library is required to use the acknowledgement statement “This project is supported by the Institute of Museum and Library Services under the provisions of the Library Services and Technology Act as administered by the Missouri State Library, a division of the Office of the Secretary of State” in all grant related items to include, but not limited to the following: pamphlets, promotions, publications, TV and radio ads, signage, library materials, documents, and on or near tangible items purchased for the grant or grant program. The two exceptions to using the aforementioned acknowledgement statement are for Facebook and X. On these social media platforms, the following will be used:

Facebook: www.facebook.com/USIMLS

X: @US_IMLS

If the grant will have an online presence (i.e. website, online collection, reader tracker, etc.), the acknowledgement will need to have a link to www.ims.gov within the acknowledgement, as in this example: This project is supported by the [Institute of Museum and Library Services](#) under the provisions of the Library Services and Technology Act as administered by the Missouri State Library, a division of the Office of the Secretary of State.

It is recommended to use the IMLS Logo in addition to the acknowledgement statement when space is available. IMLS has a logo and use webpage:
