

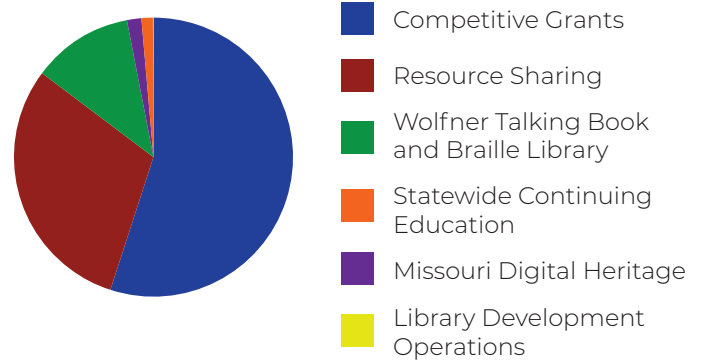
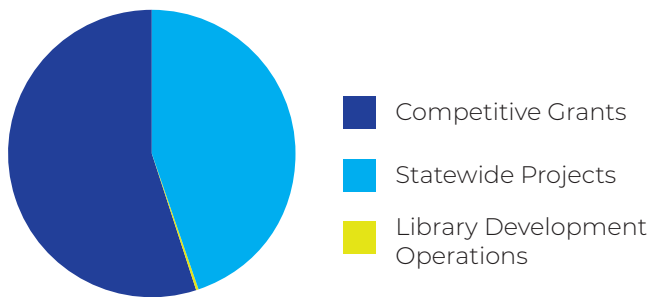

\$3.1 MILLION ALLOTMENT

LIBRARY SERVICES AND TECHNOLOGY ACT FUNDS IN MISSOURI

Of the \$3,131,845 in LSTA funds that Missouri was awarded in FY2020, \$1,714,819 was awarded to local libraries as competitive grants and \$1,408,854 was used to support projects for all libraries across the state.



SUMMER READING

144,746 children and teens participated in 5,055 summer reading programs, across 141 library districts.



RESOURCE SHARING

127 public libraries used the Statewide Courier Service to share 1,046,790 items, expanding access to library materials.



STAFF TRAINING

25,371 library staff members participated in 203 training opportunities, which helped improve library services throughout Missouri.
