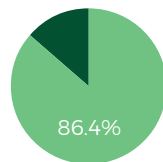

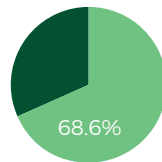

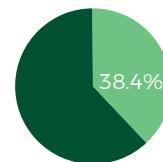

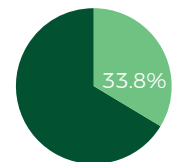

LIBRARY RESOURCES

To support workforce development, libraries provide library staff, training facilitators, strong internet connectivity, career databases and meeting rooms.



COMPUTER USE

Library patrons used public computers 4,238,490 times in 2019 for employment, to file taxes, do homework, conduct research and other activities.



LIBRARY VISITS

Public libraries had 50.5 million total in-person and online visitors in 2019. Libraries received just over \$6.2 million in state funding for FY2020.
